 - b. Trail Map Redesign (minimal cost)
 - c. Updated Natural Resource Inventory/Management Plan (large cost)
 - d. Accessibility Assessment (low cost)
 - e. General Maintenance
 - f. Chestnut Saplings (low cost)
 - g. Goat Trail Adoption (unknown costs based on DEP report): State report is waiting on the Spring for assessment of vernal pools. Possible costs could include state permits, further environmental studies, rerouting trails, bog bridging and how much might be required.
