2. Budget Conversation (\$700 remaining)
 - a. \$1400 allocated for Island Redesign
 - b. \$400 allocated for purchasing more chestnut trees
 - c. Remaining budget to be used towards purchasing posts for the future sign project or any last-minute needs that arrive before the end of the budget season.
3. Future Budget Considerations
 - a. New Trail Signage (large cost) - unlikely to happen until 2026–2027 budget cycle
 - b. Trail Map Redesign (minimal cost)
 - c. Updated Natural Resource Inventory/Management Plan (large cost)
 - d. Accessibility Assessment (low cost)
 - e. General Maintenance
 - f. Chestnut Saplings (low cost)
 - g. Goat Trail Adoption (unknown costs based on DEP report):
 - i. State report is waiting on the Spring for assessment of vernal pools. Possible costs (or lack thereof) could include state permits, further environmental studies, rerouting trails, bog bridging and how much might be required.
