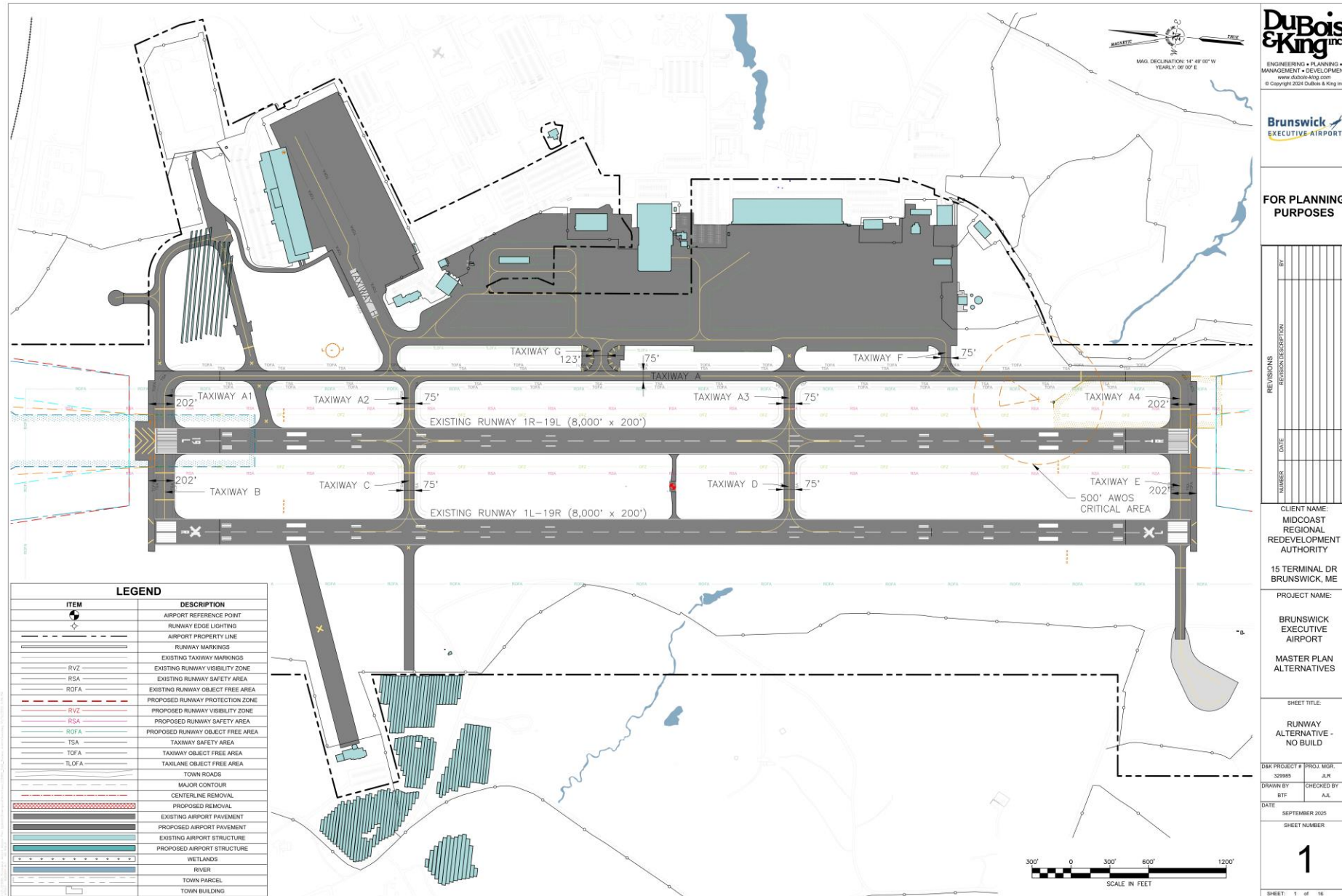

# Guiding Principles

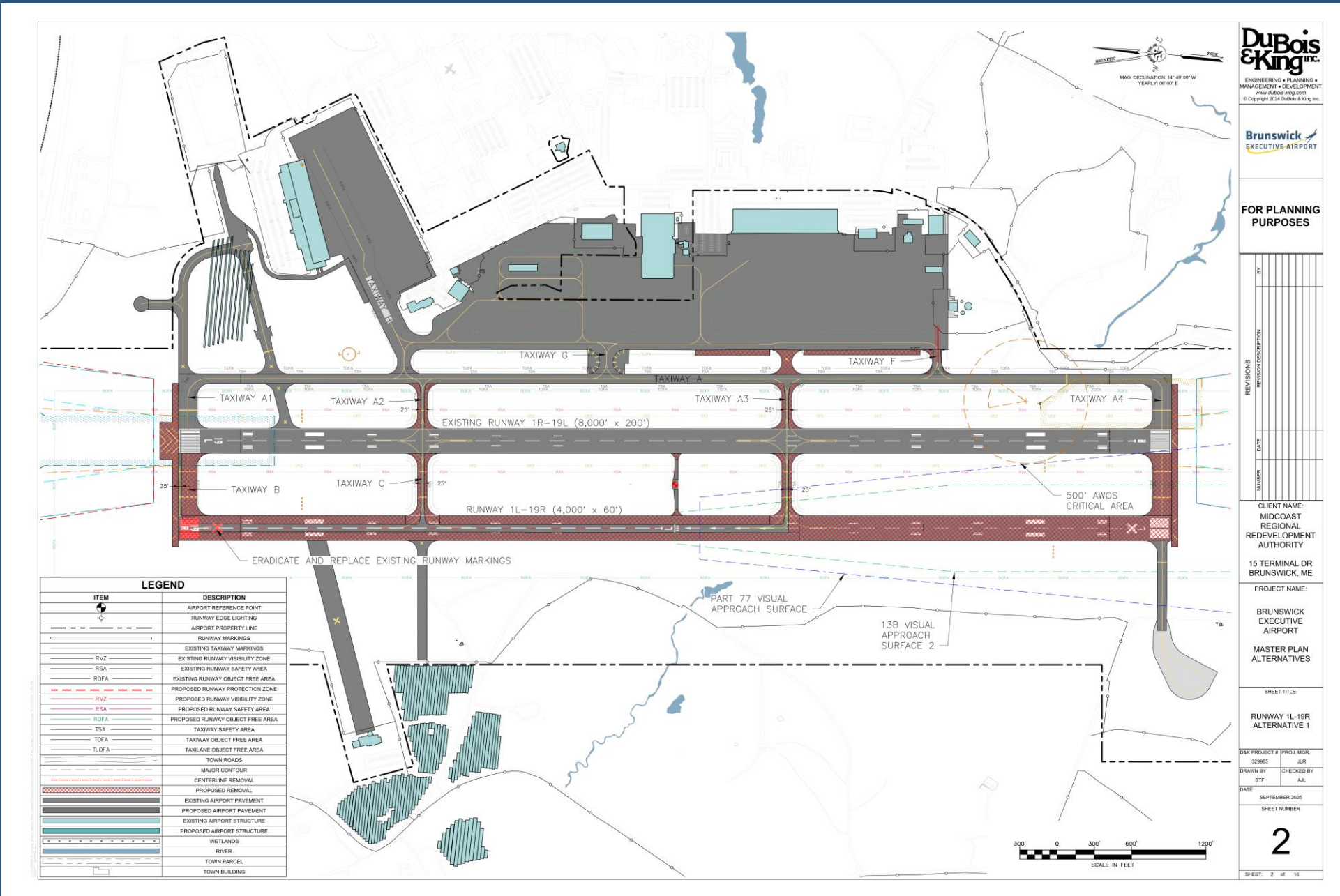


- Consider environmentally viable solutions for the current and future needs of the Airport and invest in Clean Energy Opportunities.

- Develop a Sustainable Implementation Plan and Funding Sources.
- Create an Efficient Timeline for the Airport's Future.
- Develop alternatives that advance the Airport as an economic driver, allowing it to contribute to the growth of the Town and the surrounding communities.

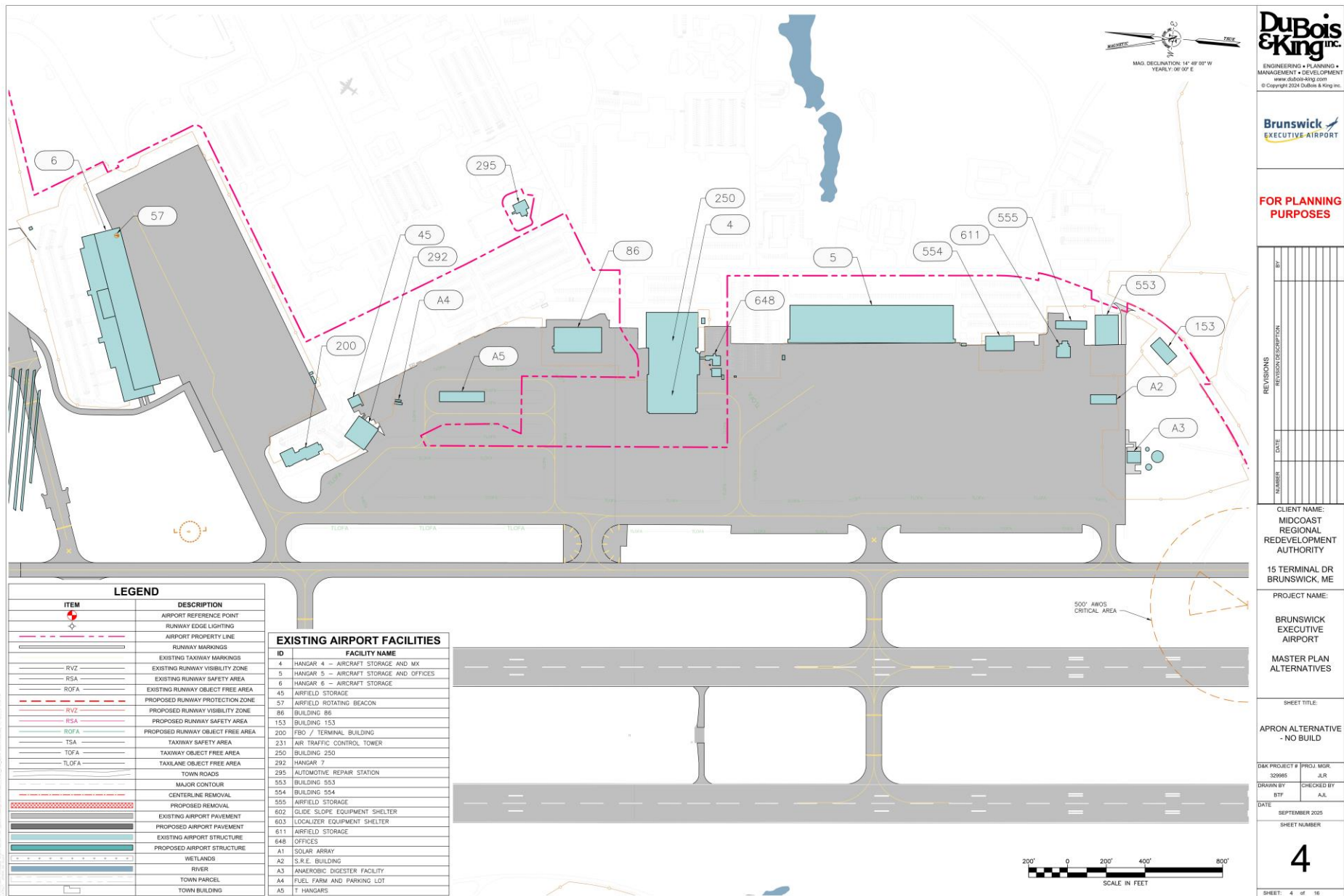


# Runway Alternative 1 – Rehabilitate 1R/19L and Minimize 1L/19R to A-I Standards

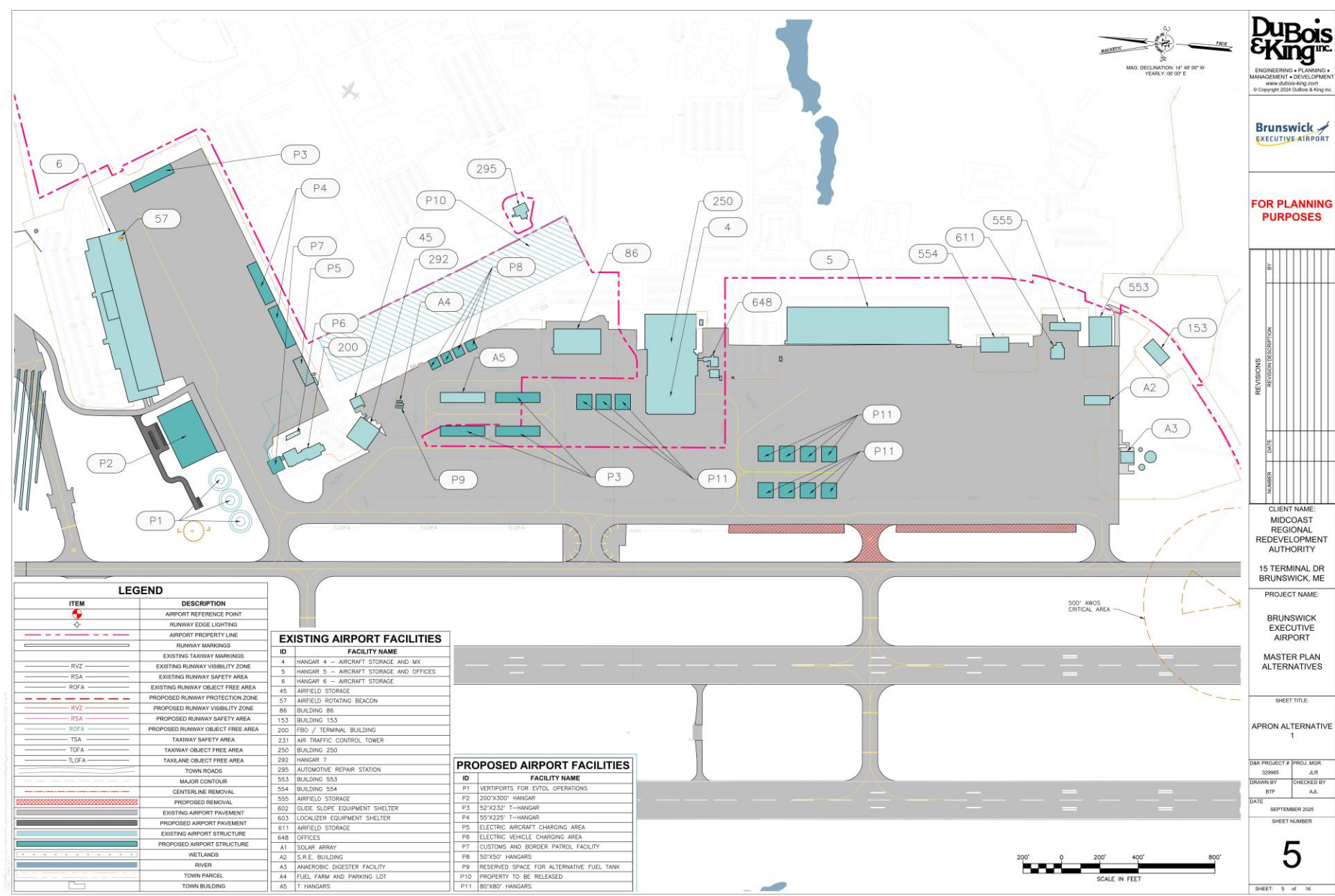




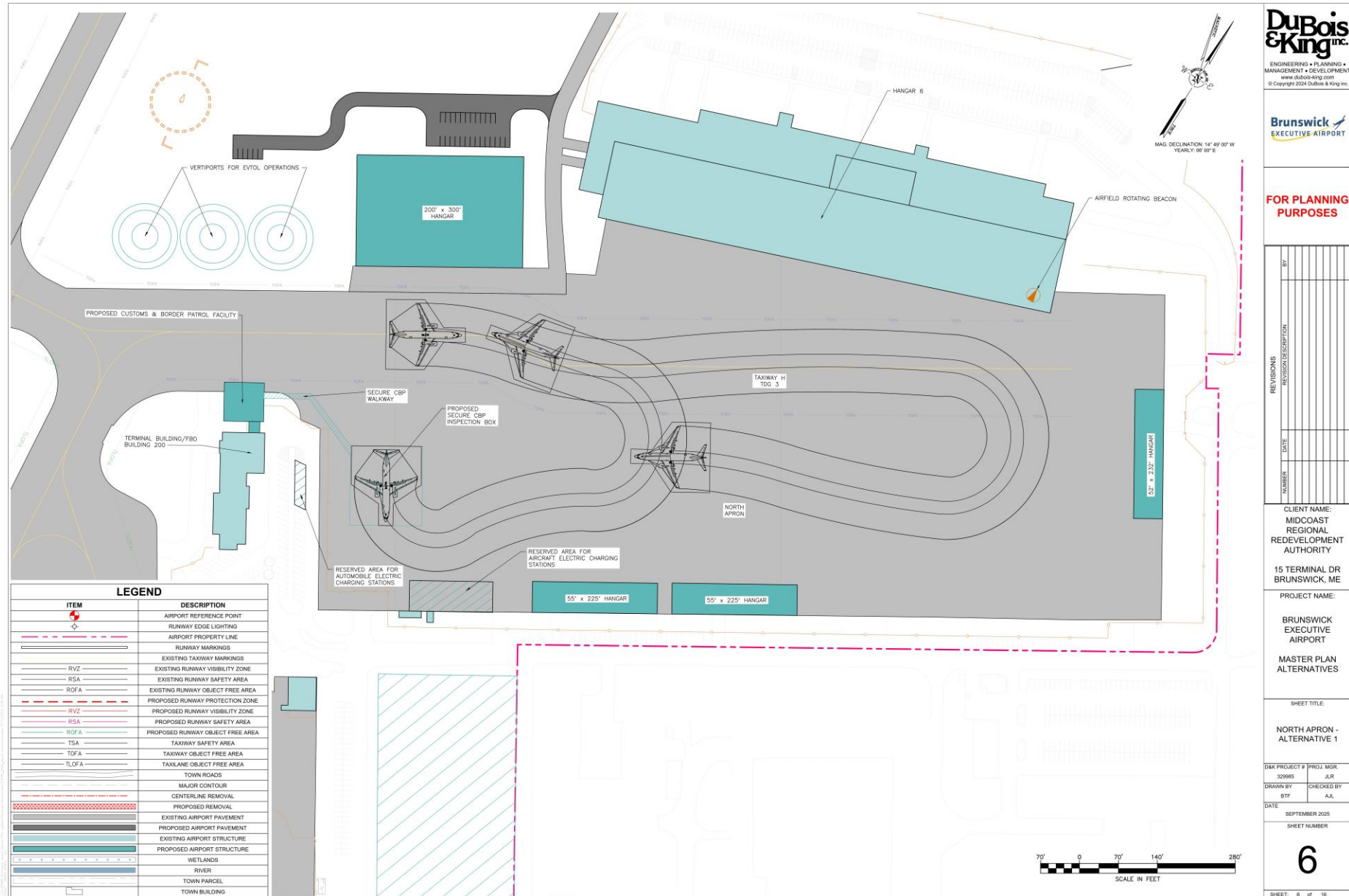

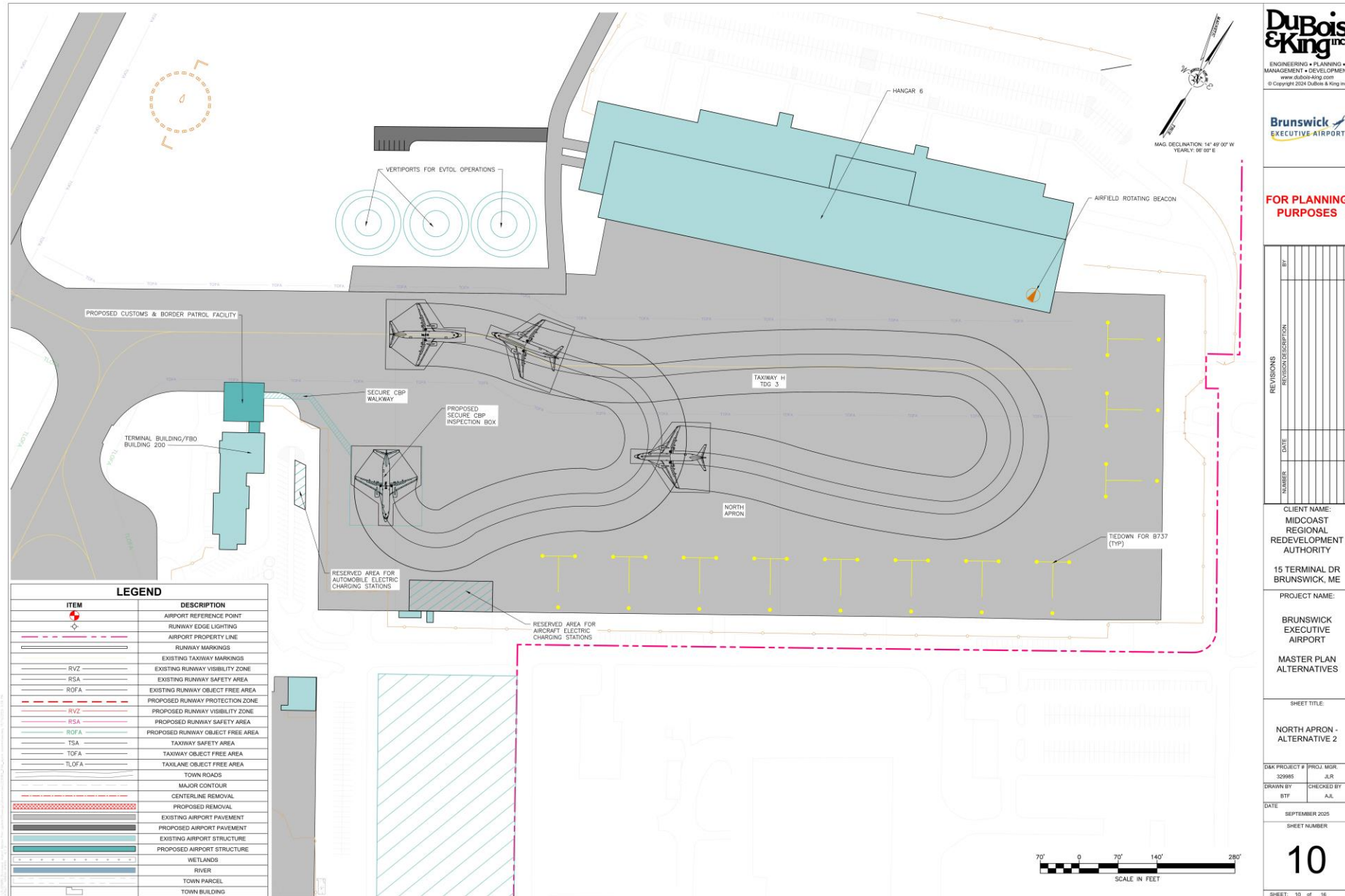

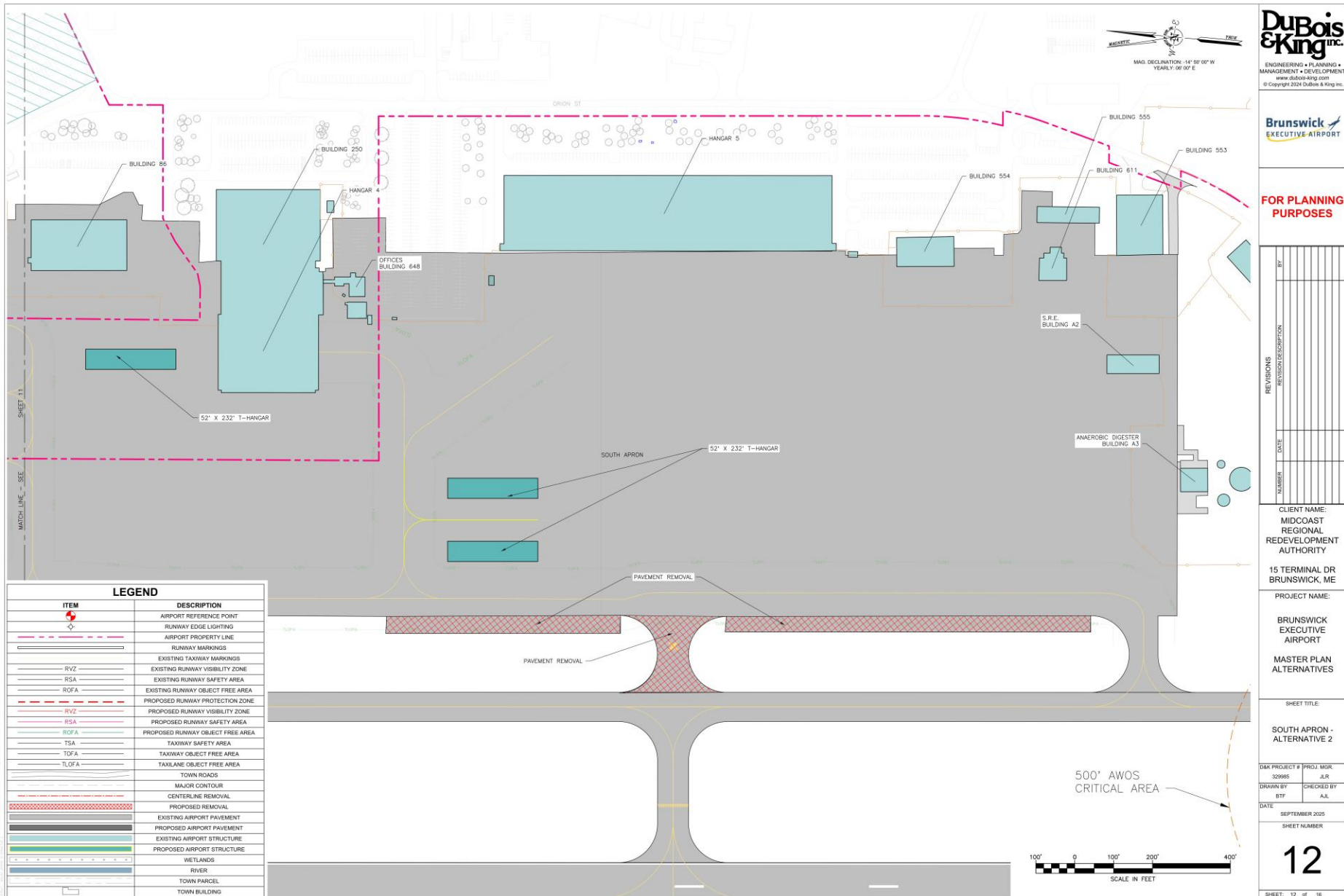
