General Policies

Registration: Registration can occur either online at www.brunswickme.gov/parks-recreation, in person at the Recreation Center, and over the phone. Full payment is required at the time of registration for classes.

Residents: Participants who live in Brunswick.

Non-Residents: Participants who do not live in Brunswick must pay 33% more per registration.

Confirmations: We do not send confirmations or reminders of enrollment. If you register for a program, you are responsible for knowing class dates, times, and location.

Discounts: Sibling discounts are available for Brunswick Youth Soccer League and for Summer Camp.

Refund Policy: Brunswick Parks and Recreation seeks to provide high quality facilities and program opportunities for leisure time activities for all Brunswick residents. The user fees collected through these programs go directly toward the cost of operation. This allows us to keep our rates fair while still delivering a high quality product. In many cases, expenses are incurred prior to the start of a program, which is why we have outlined the refund policy below.

- If we cancel a program, all fees will be refunded. If a program does not take place due to cancellation by Parks and Rec, all registration/user fees will be refunded in full.

- If you withdraw 2 business days before the first session of a program (excluding weekends and holidays) you will receive a full refund (less a \$5 handling fee). Example: If a program is scheduled to begin on a Wednesday, to receive a full refund (minus the handling fee) you must withdraw before the end of business on Monday. If Monday is a town recognized holiday and our offices are closed then withdrawal must take place before the end of business on the previous Friday.
- If you withdraw less than 2 business days prior to the start of or after the first session of a program, you will be refunded 75% of the registration fee (less a \$5 handling fee). Example: If the program is scheduled for Wednesday afternoons, any withdrawals that take place at the start of business on the Tuesday morning before the first session through the close of business on the Tuesday prior to the second session will be eligible for this refund.
- If you withdraw on (or after) the day of the second session, no refund will be issued.
- For one-day special events you must withdraw no less than 2 business days prior to the start of the program to receive a full refund (less a \$5 handling fee). There will be no refunds issued for requests later than that.
- In the event of an extended illness or injury, we will issue a prorated refund after the start of a program. We must receive written notification, along with a physicians note excusing the participant from continuing. All documentation must be received before the last session of the program.
- Refund processing takes up to two weeks. We do not provide cash refunds.

Cell Phone Policy

- Patrons are allowed to use cell phones for music and fitness-oriented apps while wearing headphones or earbuds.
- We ask Patrons to NOT use technology to photograph or videotape anywhere in the Fitness Center.
- In addition, we DO NOT PERMIT conversational phone use, facetime, or any other video conversations in the Fitness Center.
- Please refrain from scrolling through social media, texting, or taking selfies in between sets while others are waiting to use equipment in Fitness Center.

Be Involved

The Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department's Recreation Commission consists of five members who are appointed by the Town Council. The Commission meets on the third Wednesday of the month at 7:00pm and has the following general powers and duties:

- The Recreation Commission shall review programs and formulate policies related to public recreation in the Town of Brunswick, including the coordination of its programs with those of other municipal departments.
- It shall be the overall responsibility of the Recreation Commission to promote, enhance and protect recreational opportunities in Brunswick in order to maintain and further develop the quality of life and objectives set forth in the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible to set forth policies and procedures for all programs operated and administered by the Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible for the supervision of all recreational activities conducted by the department on all property owned by or under the control of the town, or on property not owned or under the control of the town.
- The Commission shall communicate with other recreational user groups to coordinate assistance, training, and use of facilities to collectively support extended recreational activities within the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall develop an appropriate plan of maintenance based on an annual budget and CIP projections for the proper maintenance of the Recreation Department building(s) and for any other recreational structures or facilities placed under its jurisdiction by the Town Council.
- The Recreation Commission will assist in the development of an annual budget.

Midcoast Athletic and Recreation Complex (the MARC)

Creating a state-of-the-art regional hub for wellness, sports, and play at Brunswick Landing

The MARC is a redevelopment of the vacant 10-acre parcel adjacent to the Brunswick Recreation Center. Per the Town's agreement with the US Navy, this land must be used for recreation purposes. Our goal is to turn this empty lot into a recreational sports and athletic complex that serves all ages and abilities from across the region. Construction of the MARC will be divided into phases.

- 1 Skatepark
- 1 Walking Loop

Anticipated completion of Phase 1 Tier 1B in June 2025

- 1 Playgrounds (ages 5-12)



The Welcome Center serves as a centralized resource for immigrants arriving in Brunswick. It provides a space for individuals accessing legal, workforce, and English language learning services and provides a hub for socializing, internet use, and childcare, among other resources. The Welcome Center is located in the back of the Brunswick Recreation Center at the Brunswick Landing. The entrance and parking lot can be found off Venture Ave.

Includes full access to strength and cardio spaces and equipment in addition to the amenities included in the Basic Membership.


SilverSneakers Pro Membership
