General Policies

Registration: Registration can occur either online at www.brunswickme.gov/parks-recreation, in person at the Recreation Center, and over the phone. Full payment is required at the time of registration for classes.

Residents: Participants who live in Brunswick.

Non-Residents: Participants who do not live in Brunswick must pay 33% more per registration.

Confirmations: We do not send confirmations or reminders of enrollment. If you register for a program, you are responsible for knowing class dates, times, and location.

Discounts: Sibling discounts are available for Brunswick Youth Soccer League and Summer Camp.

Refund Policy: Brunswick Parks and Recreation seeks to provide high quality facilities and program opportunities for leisure time activities for all Brunswick residents. The fees collected through these programs go directly toward the cost of operations. This allows us to keep our rates fair while still delivering high-quality services. In many cases, expenses are incurred prior to the start of a program, which is why we have outlined the refund policy below. **All refunds will be automatically processed to the primary account holder's account. We do not provide cash refunds.**

- **If we cancel a program**, all fees will be refunded. If a program does not take place due to cancellation by Parks and Rec staff, all registration fees will be refunded in full as credit on account unless a refund check is requested. If a refund check is requested when staff cancels the program, there will be no processing fee if the request is made within 14 days of the cancellation.
- **If you withdraw** before the first session of a program (excluding weekends and holidays), you will receive a full refund (less a \$15 processing fee). Example: If a program is scheduled to begin on a Wednesday at 5pm, to receive a full refund (minus the processing fee), you must withdraw before Wednesday at 5pm. To further clarify, withdraw means a communication with staff via phone, voicemail, email, or in person.
- **For one-day special events**, you must withdraw prior to the start of the program to receive a full refund (less a \$5 processing fee). There will be no refunds issued for requests after the one-day event occurred.
- If you are **dissatisfied** with a program after the first class, you must let the staff know before the second class of the session to receive a refund.
- In the event of an **extended illness or injury**, we will issue a prorated refund, if the program has started. We may request written notification.
- All refund requests must be received before the last session of the program. **Refunds will be denied for programs that have ended**, even if you were dissatisfied with the program or did not attend.
- If you withdraw on (or after) the day of the second session, no refund will be issued.
- **Summer Camp Refund Policy;** Prorated refunds may be issued if your camper is asked to withdraw. Prorated refunds will be calculated by week, so if your child attends Monday, then the full week will count as attended.
- **Fitness Membership Refund Policy;** memberships are non-refundable. Refunds are generally only provided in exceptional circumstances, like medical issues, and may require proper documentation.
- **All refunds will be automatically processed as a credit to the primary account holder's account.** If a refund check is requested it will take 14-21 days to process. If a refund check is requested for a cancellation made by a participant, there will be a \$15 processing fee. If a refund check is requested when staff cancels the program, there will be no processing fee if requested within 14 days of the cancellation.

Cell Phone Policy

- Patrons are allowed to use cell phones for music and fitness-oriented apps while wearing headphones or earbuds.
- We ask patrons to NOT use technology to photograph or videotape anywhere in the Fitness Center.
- In addition, we DO NOT PERMIT conversational phone use, facetime, or any other video conversations in the Fitness Center.
- Please refrain from scrolling through social media, texting, or taking selfies in between sets while others are waiting to use equipment in Fitness Center.

The Brunswick Youth Soccer League (BYSL) is a popular, community-based program designed for youth entering grades K-8 who live in Brunswick. The league's goals are to teach soccer skills in an environment that fosters player growth, encourages fun, and develops self-esteem for every player.

Early bird pricing is \$10 off list price of program, plus a \$5 sibling discount available for each additional sibling registered.

'Soccer League for K and Grade 1 (Co-Ed Division for K and Grade 1) \$65

Youth in Kindergarten and first grade will participate in BYSL's co-ed "Kids on the Pitch," a fundamental program with coaches who focus on teaching the basics of soccer through stations and drills followed by fun scrimmages. This program meets on Saturdays (no weekday practices), and players receive a team shirt at registration.

Soccer League for Grades 2 and 3 (Separate Divisions for 2-3 Boys and 2-3 Girls) \$75

Youth in Grades 2-3 will be placed on separate teams with a coach and have one weekday practice and one Saturday game. Participants receive a team shirt at registration and a soccer ball at the end of the season. Players are required to provide their own shin guards and socks. A mouth piece is optional and cleats are not needed at this age.

Soccer League for Grades 4 and 5 (Separate Divisions for 4-5 Boys and 4-5 Girls) \$85

Youth in Grades 4-5 will be placed on separate teams with a coach and have one weekday practice and one Saturday game. This division will get two extra weeknight games under the lights! Participants receive a team shirt at registration and a soccer ball at the end of the season. Players are required to provide their own shin guards and socks. A mouth piece is optional and cleats are encouraged but not required at this age.

Soccer League for Grades 6, 7 and 8 (Co-Ed Division for 6-8) \$90

Youth in Grades 6-8 will be placed on co-ed teams with a coach and have one weekday practice and one Saturday game. This division will get two extra weeknight games under the lights! Participants receive a team shirt at registration and a soccer ball at the end of the season. Players are required to provide their own shin guards and socks. A mouth piece is encouraged and cleats are strongly recommended at this age.

- Keep hands and loose clothes away from weight stacks, cables, and pulleys. Limit use of cardio machines to 30 minutes when others are waiting.
- Proper attire is required at all times. Please do not leave personal items lying around. Use provided locker area.
- Do not take pictures or videos of others without consent.
- Please use headphones when listening to music.
- Please clean up after yourself and wipe off equipment with provided materials after use.
- Track use is limited to walking and running only. Use clean non-marking gym shoes on courts, track, and exercise spaces.
- Consult your physician prior to engaging in physical activity.

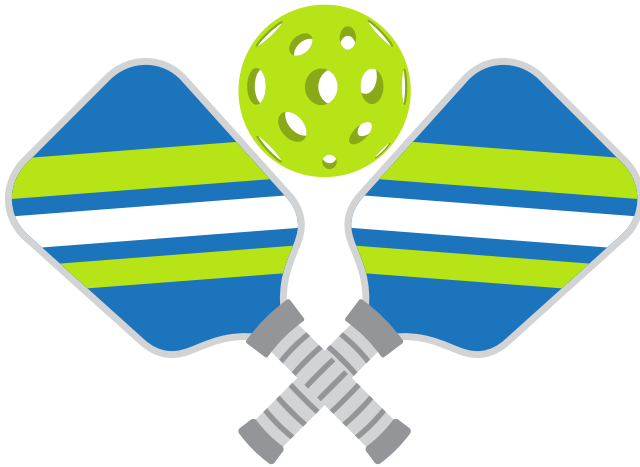

Be Involved

The Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department's Recreation Commission consists of five members who are appointed by the Town Council. The Commission meets on the third Wednesday of the month at 7:00pm and has the following general powers and duties:

- The Recreation Commission shall review programs and formulate policies related to public recreation in the Town of Brunswick, including the coordination of its programs with those of other municipal departments.
- It shall be the overall responsibility of the Recreation Commission to promote, enhance and protect recreational opportunities in Brunswick in order to maintain and further develop the quality of life and objectives set forth in the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible to set forth policies and procedures for all programs operated and administered by the Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible for the supervision of all recreational activities conducted by the department on all property owned by or under the control of the town, or on property not owned or under the control of the town.
- The Commission shall communicate with other recreational user groups to coordinate assistance, training, and use of facilities to collectively support extended recreational activities within the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall develop an appropriate plan of maintenance based on an annual budget and CIP projections for the proper maintenance of the Recreation Department building(s) and for any other recreational structures or facilities placed under its jurisdiction by the Town Council.
- The Recreation Commission will assist in the development of an annual budget.

Midcoast Athletic and Recreation Complex (the MARC)

Creating a state-of-the-art regional hub for wellness, sports, and play at Brunswick Landing

The MARC is a redevelopment of the vacant 10-acre parcel adjacent to the Brunswick Recreation Center. Per the Town's agreement with the US Navy, this land must be used for recreation purposes. Our goal is to turn this empty lot into a recreational sports and athletic complex that serves all ages and abilities from across the region. Construction of the MARC will be divided into phases.

- 8 Pickleball Courts
- 1 Skatepark
- 1 Walking Loop

Anticipated completion of Phase 1 Tier 1B in June 2025

- Playground for ages 0-5

Other Phase 1 elements yet to be completed include:

- 1 Multi-purpose Natural Grass Field
- 2 Basketball Courts
- 2 Tennis Courts
- 1 Playgrounds (ages 5-12)

Welcome Center

Community Room at the Welcome Center

The Welcome Center serves as a centralized resource for immigrants arriving in Brunswick. It provides a space for individuals accessing legal, workforce, and English language learning services and provides a hub for socializing, internet use, and childcare, among other resources. The Welcome Center is located in the back of the Brunswick Recreation Center at the Brunswick Landing. The entrance and parking lot can be found off Venture Ave.

The Community Room is staffed by Rodrigue Mwenge, courtesy of the Immigrant Resource Center of Maine. It is open by appointment only from 9am-5pm Monday thru Friday.

Includes full access to strength and cardio spaces and equipment in addition to the amenities included in the Basic Membership.

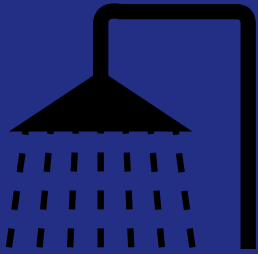
SilverSneakers Pro Membership
