News: Brunswick's Climate Action Plan Passes

PLANNING FOR A CLIMATE-RESILIENT BRUNSWICK

By an unanimous vote on 16 December 2024, Brunswick's Town Council accepted a new Climate Action Plan. The comprehensive document demonstrates our town's commitment to fostering a healthy, sustainable future by decreasing greenhouse gas emissions and increasing the town's resilience. The plan was developed by Brunswick's Climate Action Task Force, which benefited from the wide-ranging expertise of its members as well as feedback contributed by the public via in-person forums and online surveys. With implementation tied to specific targets set for 2030, 2040, and 2050, Brunswick's employees, council members, and committees are now actively employing the plan to guide development of climate-related actions and policies. 

The Androscoggin Swinging Bridge is one of Brunswick's hidden gems! Originally built in 1892 for mill workers to cross the river, this bridge links Brunswick with Topsham & provides a beautiful trail loop that is perfect for outdoor walking during winter or mud seasons.
