# ONLINE REGISTRATION

## For Existing Brunswick Parks & Recreation Families (2011- Present)

If any member of your family's household has registered for a program with us after 2011 you already have an active household account! If you have never taken advantage of the WebTrac Online Registration platform, however, you do not have login credentials attached to your account yet.

**Please do not create a new household in order to login!** Call us at 207-725-6656 or email [recprograms@brunswickme.org](mailto:recprograms@brunswickme.org) and we will assist you with assigning login information to your already existing household account.

If you are not sure whether your login credentials have been set up or if you have forgotten your username or password, please reach out to us using the contact information provided above and we will assist you with this as well!

**Please Note: If you don't contact us and you choose to register a new account, you will be creating a duplicate household in our system. You will also be considered a Non-Resident until verified through our office and charged Non-Resident enrollment fees.**

## For NEW Brunswick Parks & Recreation Families That Have Never Registered for a Program

If you have never signed up for a program with us in the past you can create an account by going to our [WebTrac](#) Online Registration page and selecting the need a new account link. You will then be prompted to start an account. Your account will be active once complete, however you will be recognized as a Non-Resident by default.

You will need to visit the Recreation Center during business hours (Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4:30p.m) to verify residency in order to be charged resident fees. We will accept a current utility statement, Town of Brunswick tax statement, or current driver's license as proof of residency. ## General Policies

**Registration:** Registration can occur either in person at the Recreation Department, over the phone, by mail OR online at [www.brunswickme.org/parks-recreation](http://www.brunswickme.org/parks-recreation)

**Registration Process:** Pre-registration and pre-payment are required for all classes. Programs registrations are accepted in person, mail, online, or over the phone. Payment is expected prior to the start of the first class date.

**Payment:** Full payment is required at the time of registration for classes.

**Residents:** Participants who live in Brunswick. Verification of Brunswick address is required.

**Non-Residents:** Participants who do not live in Brunswick must pay 1.33% more per class registration.

**Confirmations:** We do not send course confirmations or reminders of enrollment. If you register for a program, you are responsible for knowing class dates, times, and location.

**Discounts:** Brunswick Parks and Recreation does NOT offer a senior discount. Sibling discounts are available for Brunswick Youth Soccer League and for Summer Vacation Camp.

**Refund Policy:** The Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department seeks to provide high quality facilities and program opportunities for leisure time activities for all Brunswick residents. The user fees that are collected through these programs go directly toward the cost of operation. This allows us to keep our rates fair and reasonable while still delivering a high quality product. In many cases, expenses are incurred prior to the start of a program, which is why we have outlined the refund policy below.

- ⇒ If we cancel a program, all fees will be refunded. If a program does not take place due to cancellation by the Parks and Recreation Department, all registration/user fees will be refunded in full.
- ⇒ If you withdraw 2 business days before the first session of a program (excluding weekends and holidays) you will receive a full refund (less a \$5 handling fee). Example: If a program is scheduled to begin on a Wednesday, to receive a full refund (minus the handling fee) you must withdraw before the end of business on Monday. If Monday is a town recognized holiday and our offices are closed then withdrawal must take place before the end of business on the previous Friday.
- ⇒ If you withdraw less than 2 business days prior to the start of or after the first session of a program, you will be refunded 75% of the registration fee (less a \$5 handling fee). Example: If the program is scheduled for Wednesday afternoons, any withdrawals that take place at the start of business on the Tuesday morning before the first session through the close of business on the Tuesday prior to the second session will be eligible for this refund.
- ⇒ If you withdraw on (or after) the day of the second session, no refund will be issued.
- ⇒ For one-day special events you must withdraw no less than 2 business days prior to the start of the program to receive a full refund (less a \$5 handling fee). There will be no refunds issued for requests later than that.
- ⇒ In the event of an extended illness or injury, we will issue a prorated refund after the start of a program. We must receive written notification, along with a physicians note excusing the participant from continuing. All documentation must be received before the last session of the program.
- ⇒ Refund processing takes up to two weeks. We do not provide cash refunds.

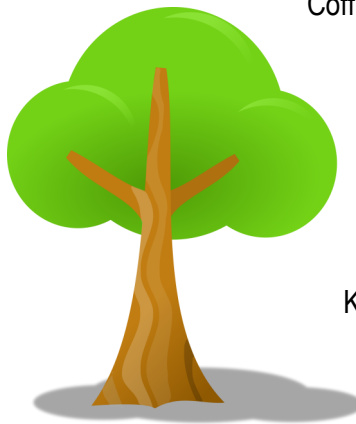

## Open Gym

The Brunswick Recreation Center offers multiple time slots throughout the week for individuals or families to stop by and use the gym space. This service is free to the public and we offer some basic equipment such as pickleball nets and basketballs. If you would like to use the space for other activities please check with staff first.

Open Use = Any age use

# Midcoast Athletic & Recreation Complex (MARC)

## Creating a state-of-the-art regional hub for wellness, sports, and play at Brunswick Landing

The Midcoast Athletic & Recreation Complex (MARC) project grew out of a grassroots group of Brunswick residents passionate about sports and recreation. We noticed that our community lacked certain recreation facilities that we've seen benefit other small towns across the state and nation.

In 2020, the U.S. Navy conveyed a 10-acre parcel on Brunswick Landing to the Town of Brunswick for specifically for recreation purposes. An advisory committee was launched in summer 2021 with the mission to dream big and create a plan to bring more sports, athletic, and recreation opportunities to kids, adults, seniors, and families in the Region.

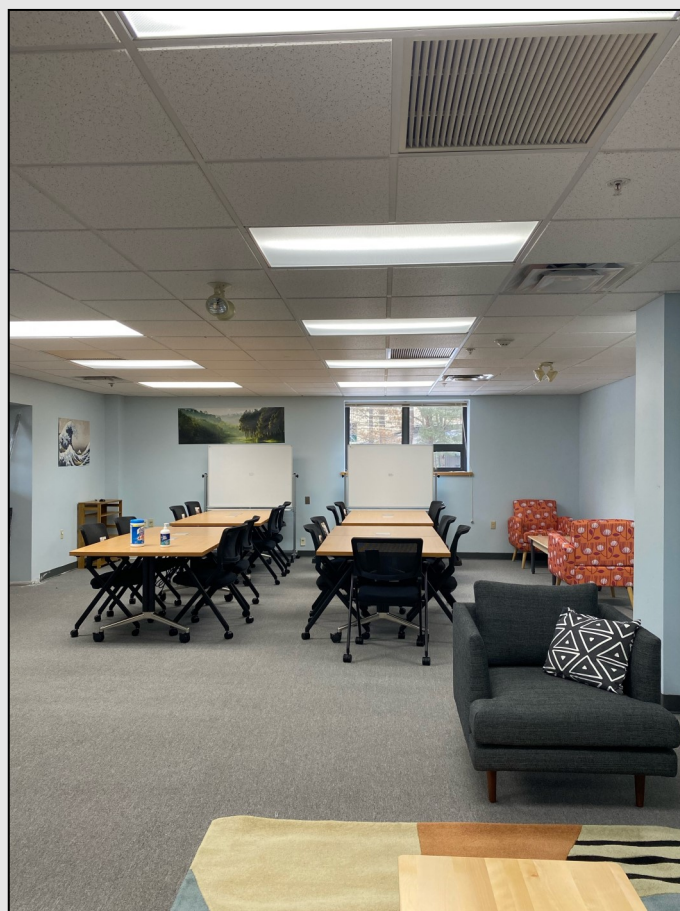

The Welcome Center serves as a centralized resource for immigrants arriving in Brunswick. It provides a space for individuals accessing legal, workforce, and English language learning services and provides a hub for socializing, internet use, and childcare, among other resources. The Welcome Center is located in the back of the Brunswick Recreation Center at the Brunswick Landing. The entrance and parking lot can be found off Venture Ave.

## English Language Learning Opportunities

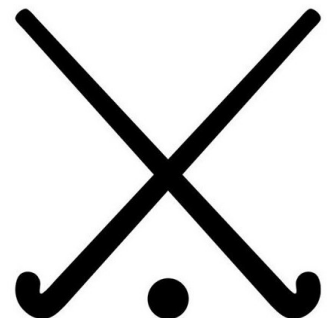

## Pick-up Pickleball

Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the United States, as all ages have started to pick up a paddle and learn more about this fun and active sport. Pickleball is a fun and exciting (and addictive) racquet sport, which differs from tennis by utilizing a court less than half the size of a tennis court. It is primarily played as a doubles sport which means each person only has to cover about ten feet of court side-to-side. The rules are few and simple and the game utilizes an underhand serve, perforated plastic ball and "no-smash zone," seven feet in front of the net which allows for an easy-to-learn sport with a slower finesse-style of play.

A pickleball court has the same dimensions as a badminton court (44 by 20 feet) with a net that is two inches lower than a tennis net. The sport is played with wooden or composite paddles that are about twice the size of a ping pong paddle and a perforated plastic ball similar to a whiffle ball.

This indoor program offers 2 courts for a drop-in style play and allows adults to play many times throughout the week. This indoor program allows adults to come down and play a game that is best described as human ping pong! This program is welcoming new players all the time, be sure to come down and check it out!

The Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department Recreation Commission consists of five (5) members who are appointed by the Town Council and the Recreation Commission meets on the third Wednesday of the month at 7:00pm. The Recreation Commission has the following general powers and duties:

- The Recreation Commission shall review programs and formulate policies related to public recreation in the Town of Brunswick, including the coordination of its programs with those of other municipal departments.
- It shall be the overall responsibility of the Recreation Commission to promote, enhance and protect recreational opportunities in Brunswick in order to maintain and further develop the quality of life and objectives set forth in the Comprehensive Plan of the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible to set forth policies and procedures for all programs operated and administered by the Brunswick Parks and Recreation Department.
- The Recreation Commission shall be responsible for the supervision of all recreational activities conducted by the department on all property owned by or under the control of the town, or on property not owned or under the control of the town.
- The Commission shall communicate with other recreational user groups to coordinate assistance, training, and use of facilities to collectively support extended recreational activities within the Town of Brunswick.
- The Recreation Commission shall develop an appropriate plan of maintenance based on an annual budget and CIP projections for the proper maintenance of the Recreation Department building(s) and for any other recreational structures or facilities placed under its jurisdiction by the Town Council.
- The Recreation Commission will assist in the development of an annual budget.
