- ▶ Ensure compliance with state laws and local ordinances regarding vitals, licensing, and elections
- ▶ Provide great customer service to residents of Brunswick and other town departments

2024-25 Proposed Budget

- ▶ Projected Expenditures - \$612,846
(increase of \$34,389 – primarily staff wages and benefits)
- ▶ Revenues Projected - \$183,587
(Increase of \$10,376)

Town Clerk Responsibilities

- ▶ Facilitating & Supervising Elections
- ▶ Maintaining Voter Information
- ▶ Issuing Variety of Licenses
- ▶ Responsible for Town's Vital Records
- ▶ Maintain Town Records
(Agendas/Minutes, Ordinances,
Permanent Record)

Town Clerk Responsibilities

- ▶ Oversees Mall/Special Event Permits
- ▶ Maintain webpage for Clerk, Council, several boards, and assist other departments
- ▶ Maintain Board/Committees Information and Database
- ▶ Miscellaneous services – Notary, DBA filings, Campaign Finance, oaths)


Transactions 2023

Recreational & Commercial


Transactions 2023



Elections

- ▶ In 2024, the Town will have 3 elections – March Presidential Primary, June Primary/School Budget/Region 10 Question
- ▶ Preparation begins 3 months prior and includes:
 - Getting election workers for absentees and Election Day
 - Preparing for and holding Election worker training
 - Creating and Testing ballots
 - Preparing supplies for polls
 - Responding to many, many election related questions
 - Conducting Absentee voting (in person, phone and electronic requests and at nursing homes)

Brunswick Election Turnout November Even Years


