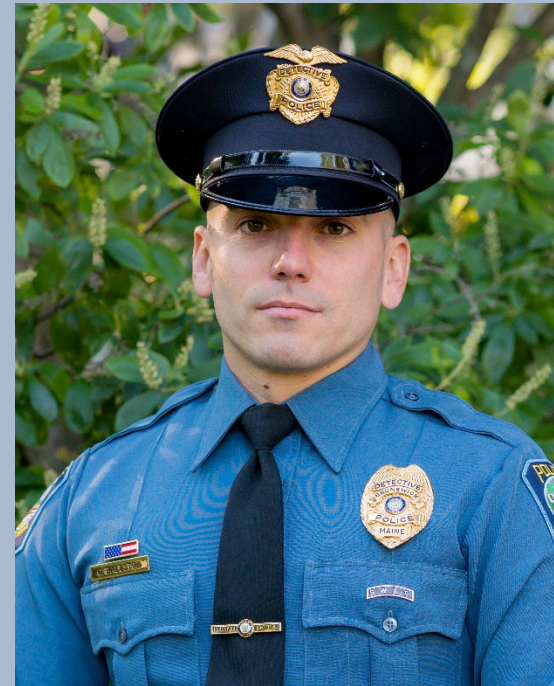

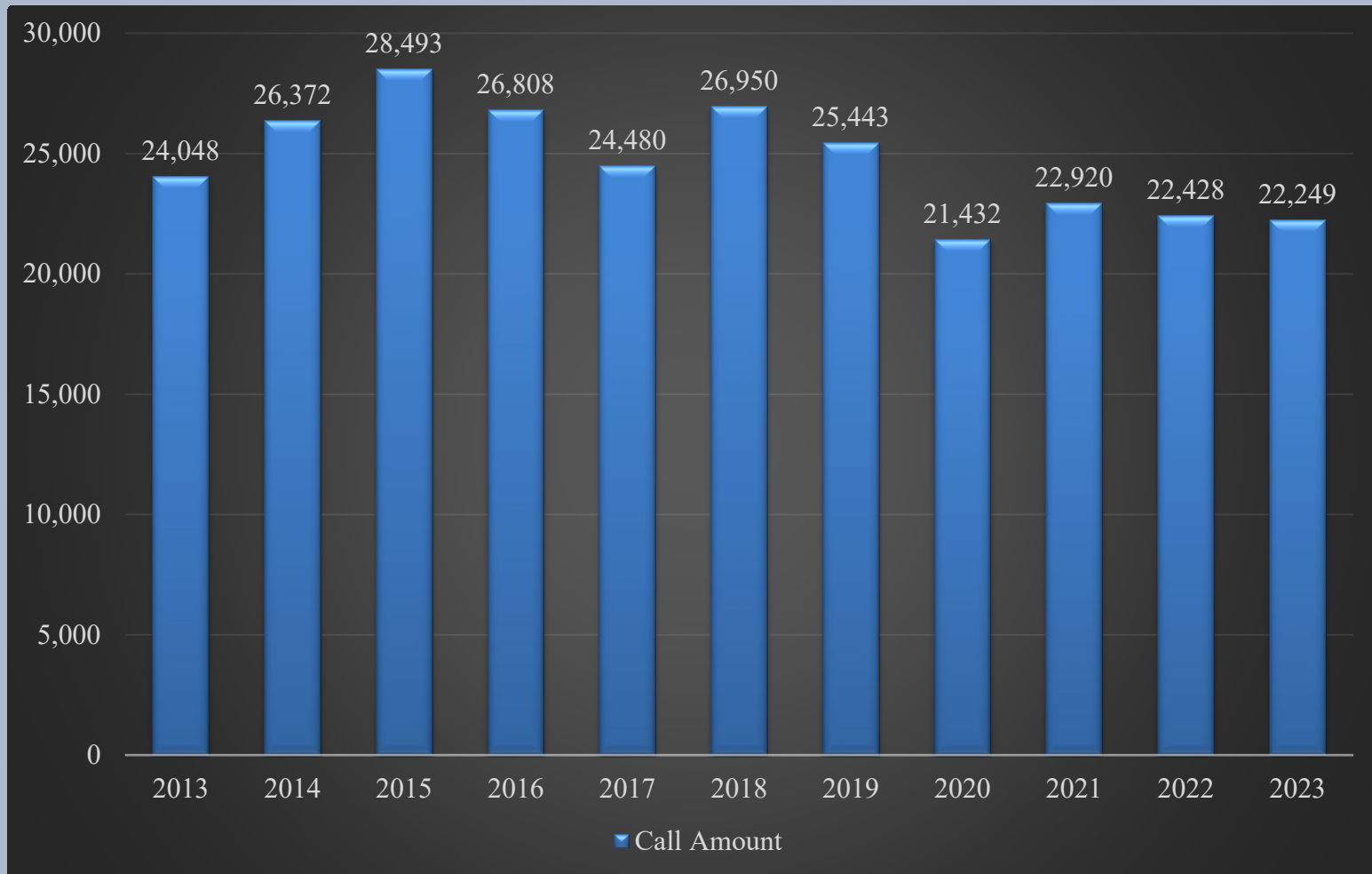
Committee Recommendations



- We require Culture Diversity Training every year – (not required through MCJA)
- Officers are attending a Cultural Awareness Training in conjunction with Maine Health
- Signed an agreement with National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) in March of 2022 to collect and submit data relating to mental health calls for service
- Added additional people to our Crisis Negotiation Team (trained by the FBI)
- 2023 – partnership with Sagadahoc County for a Mental Health Liaison
- Mandatory in person mental health training for ALL staff with a licensed clinician. Focus on individual mental health as well as recognizing those exhibiting mental health issues. Additional training is scheduled for May of 2024 with a Dr. of Psychology.

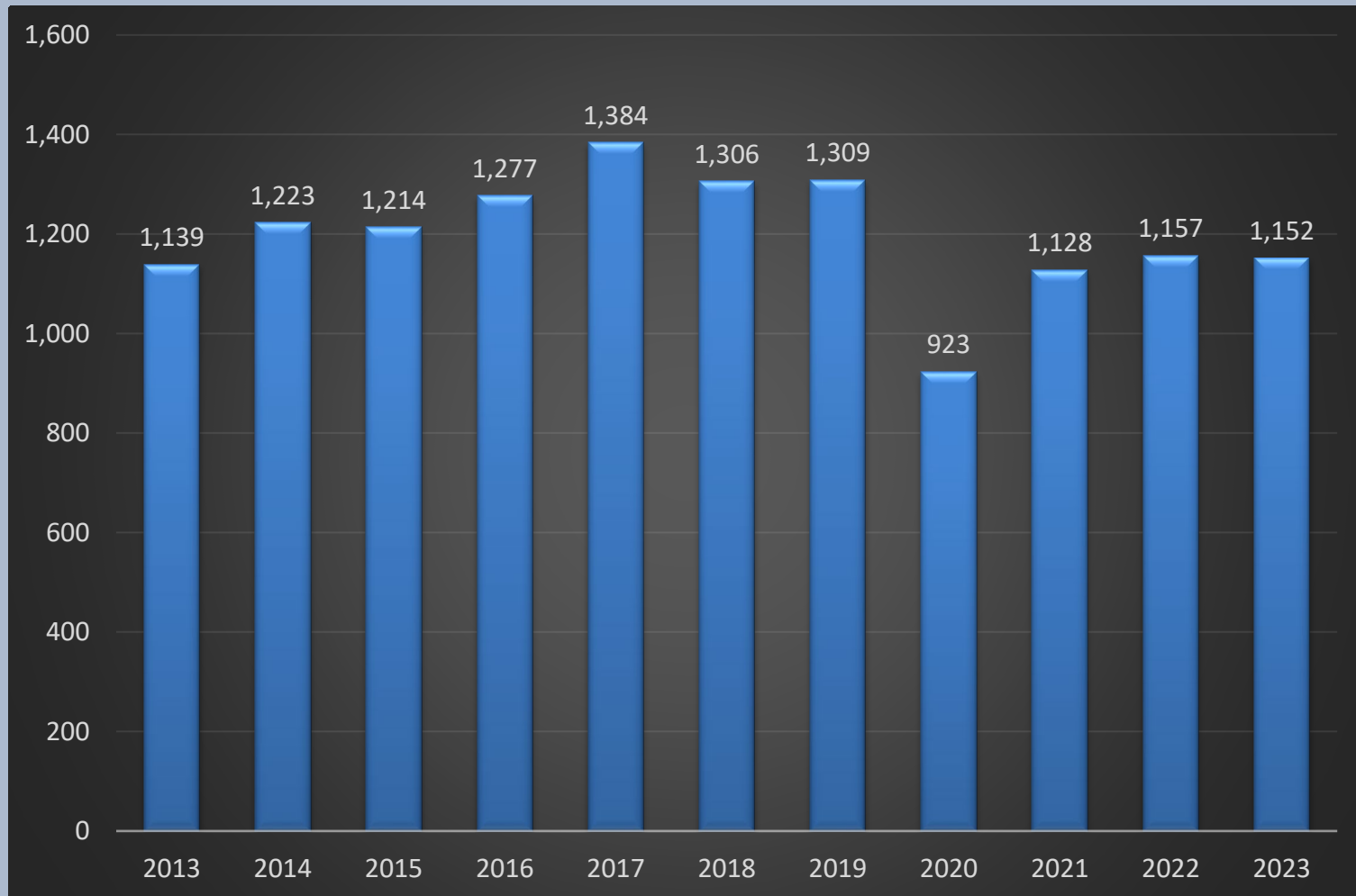

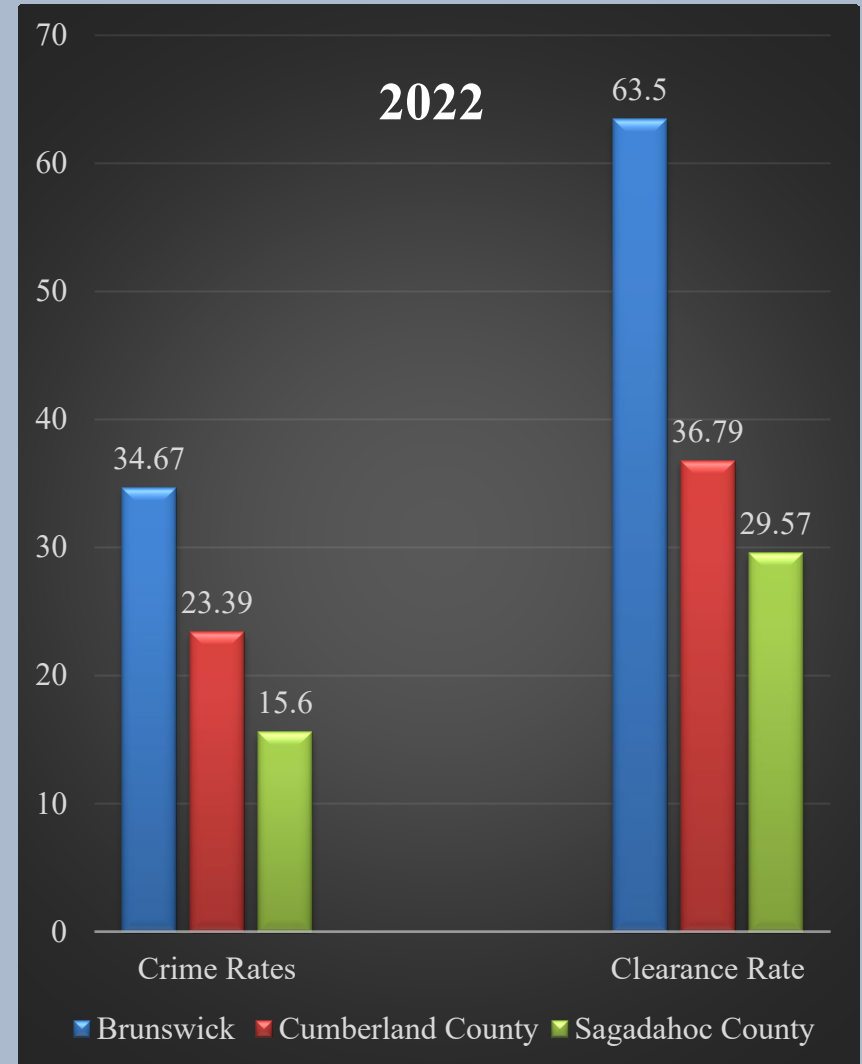
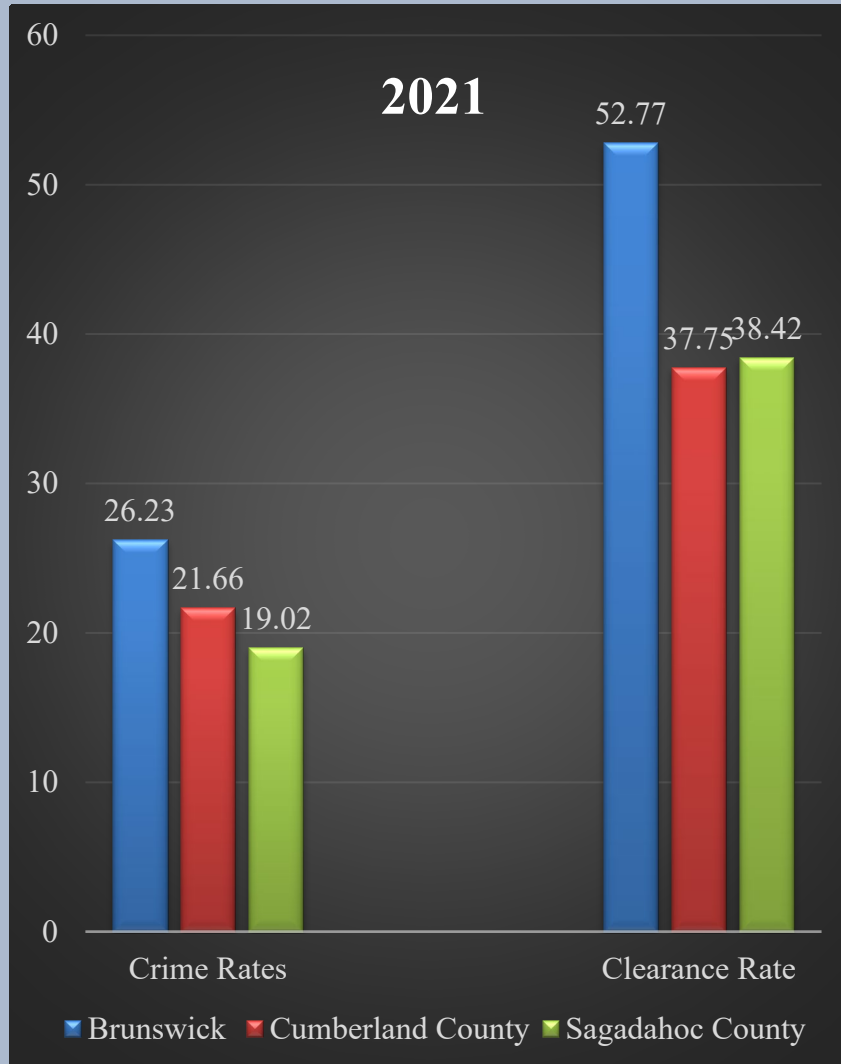


Motor Vehicle Crashes



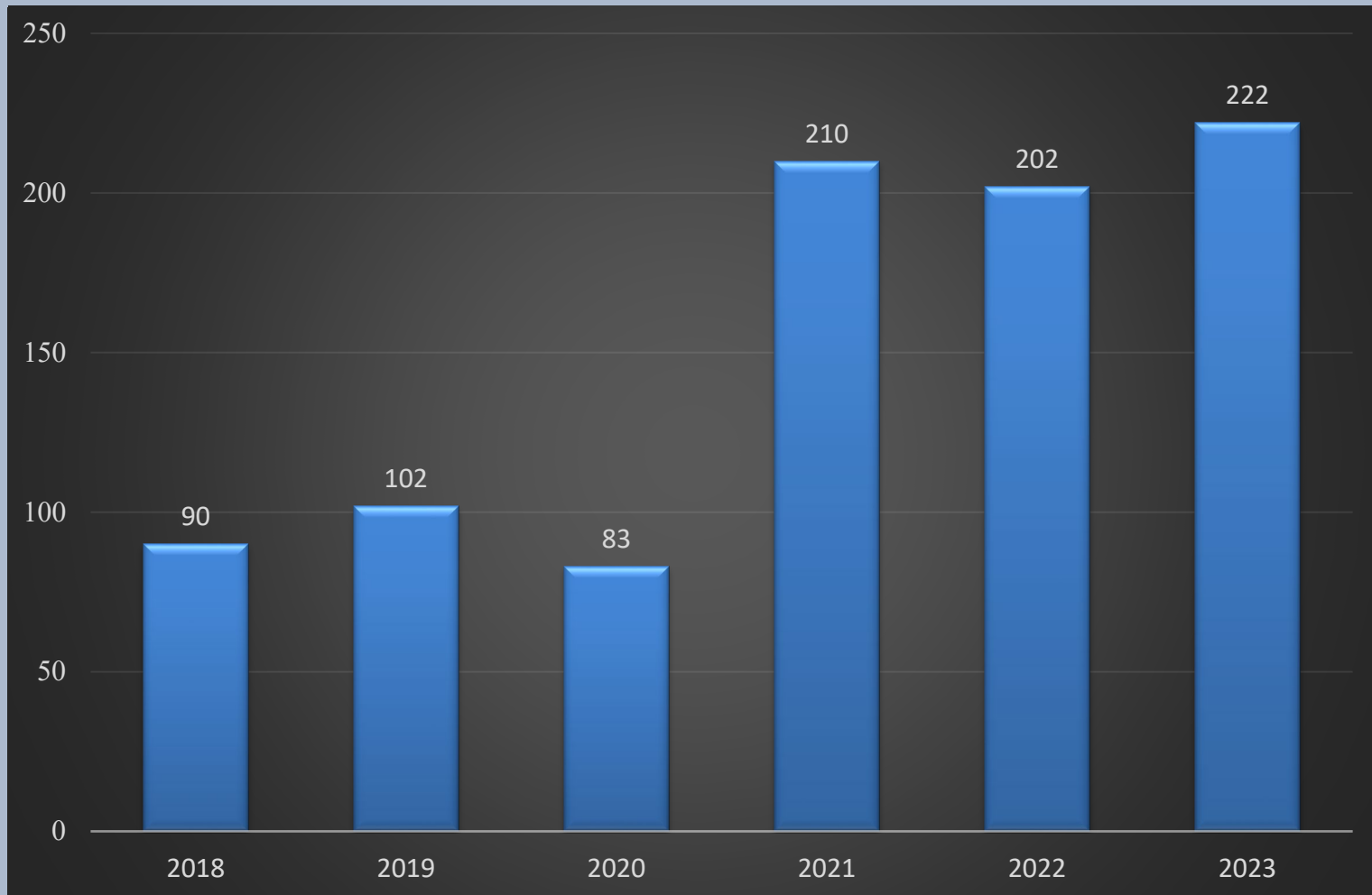


Crime Rates



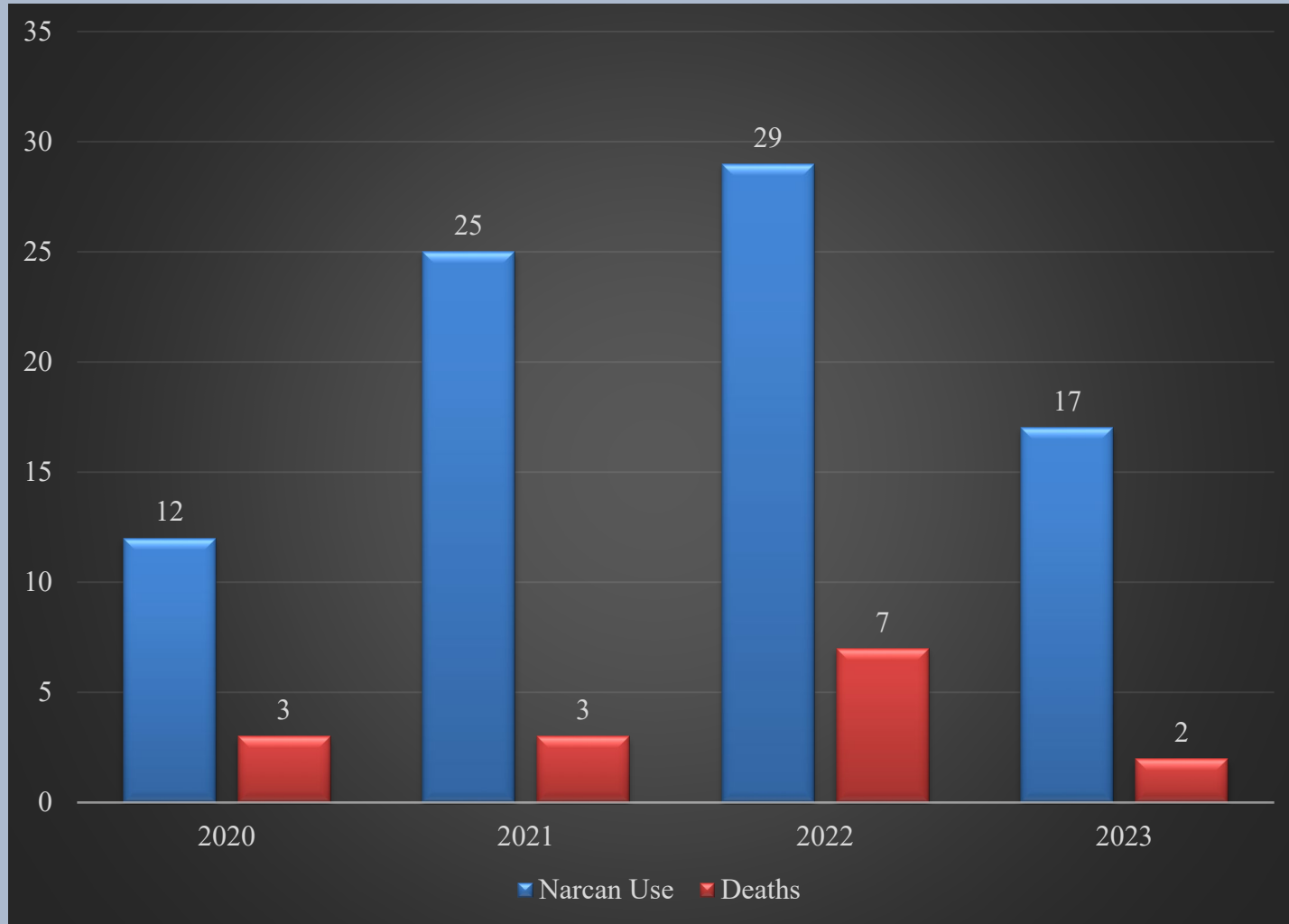


2018 - 2023 Drug Arrests





Narcan Use 2020 - 2023





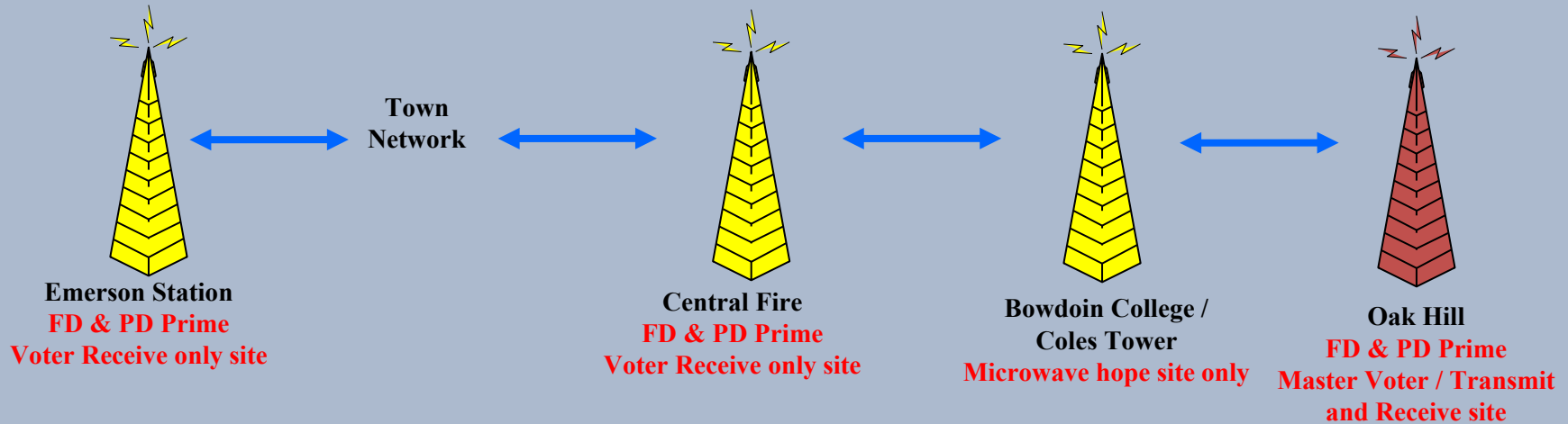
Drug Takeback

- Limited coverage / dead-spots
- Analog narrow-band system



Updated Communications System



- Digital Mobile Radio (DMR)
- Benefit to both Police and Fire Departments
- Simulcast 4 transmit AND receive sites
- Increased coverage
- Enhanced quality
- Built in redundancy / backup
- Funded through Congressional Direct Funding and American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)
